



## Little League® International Graphic Design Internship – Summer 2019

Little League® International is seeking qualified, well-rounded students to join Little League’s graphic design efforts at headquarters in Williamsport, Pennsylvania.

Reporting to Little League’s Graphic Designers, successful candidates will assist in design projects, social media graphics, print shop projects, administrative tasks, and other daily tasks as assigned. The internship will run from approximately mid-May to September. Candidate must be available to work during the 2019 Little League Baseball® World Series in mid-August. The ideal candidate will be self-motivated, organized, and have excellent communication skills. The minimal level of education is a college junior or senior enrolled in a relevant Graphic Design program.

Preferred fields of study include: Graphic Arts, Marketing Design, etc.

### Examples of possible work (depending on each candidate) could include:

- Support the Graphic Arts Coordinator in print and post production process within Little League’s print shop.
- Assist in various graphic design projects including social media posts, postcards, flyers.
- Resize artwork for online and print purposes.
- Perform finishing tasks for print items, including book trimming, ticket cutting, etc. Individuals applying should be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
- Package and prepare various printed items for shipping.
- Utilize the Industry Standard Print Software, “Fiery” System.
- Operate Sharp Color/Black and White printers.

### Preferred candidates will demonstrate the following:

- Excellent communication skills
- Strong organizational skills
- Strong computer skills
- College Junior or Senior or enrolled in relevant program
- Education requirement: Junior or Senior in active participation in a Graphic Arts program, (Typography, Color Theory and Layout classes)
- Photography, After Effects (not required)
- Program knowledge Adobe (InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator, Adobe Acrobat)
